

Cookie Policy

Pursuant to art. 13 and 14 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679

The website <https://www.iowdictionary.org/> uses cookies necessary to ensure the correct functioning of one or more sections of the website and to facilitate users' navigation.

What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files generated by the websites visited by the user, which save session information that could be used later on the website. The data allows the website to keep user information between pages and facilitate user navigation on his return.

There can be different types of cookies:

TECHNICAL COOKIES

They are necessary for the correct functioning of one or more sections of the Site. They can be:

PERSISTENT - When you close the browser they are not destroyed, but remain up to the preset expiration date;

SESSION - They are destroyed every time the browser is closed.

NAVIGATION COOKIES (OR SESSION):

These cookies are necessary to ensure the correct use of the website and its services, allowing, for example, to authenticate to reserved areas.

FUNCTIONAL COOKIE:

These cookies allow the user to express preferences on certain aspects of navigation (for example, store some favourite products in a web purchase or select the preferred language).

ANALYTICS COOKIE (OR STATISTICAL):

They are considered "technical cookies" when used directly by the site operator to collect information, in aggregate form, on the number of users and how they visit the site.

PROFILING COOKIE:

These are useful cookies to create user profiles with the aim of sending advertising messages in line with the preferences expressed by the user within the pages of the Site.

THIS WEBSITE USES TECHNICAL COOKIES

Cookies that allow the correct functioning of one or more areas of the site and facilitate navigation of the website.

DISABLING COOKIES

Reaffirming the importance of some cookies used for proper navigation, the user can delete them through different procedures related to the browser used.
